## Construction overview

Memorial Drive will soon be transformed into an attractive, shady and inclusive place for residents, businesses, and visitors to enjoy all year round.

The streetscape upgrade features more tranquil outdoor seating, more shade, more trees and plants, safer pedestrian crossings with improved accessibility for everyone, and heritage interpretation and art elements.

To minimise impacts to our community and businesses, construction will take place in two stages.

- Stage One works are fully funded and will be constructed from August 2024 to February 2025.
- Stage Two works are subject to further technical investigations and funding and are anticipated to start in 2025. We will continue to keep our community informed.

This construction notification focuses on Stage One works only.

## Construction staging

Based on recent feedback from our community including liaison with adjacent local businesses, Stage One construction will be undertaken as follows.

## **August to October 2024**

### **Memorial Drive at Bank Arcade**

- Raised pedestrian crossing
- Seating area
- Wayfinding signage
- Upgraded footpath and new pram ramp
- Footpath extension for planting
- Landscaping
- Water fountain and bins
- Roadway/crossing lighting
- Public art projected lighting.

## October 2024 to February 2025\* **Memorial Drive at Etheridge Street**

Raised pedestrian crossing

- Seating area including high bar and stools
- Wayfinding signage
- Upgraded footpath and new pram ramp

- Footpath extension for planting
- Landscaping
- 'Bullock Circle' (heritage interpretation)
- Bicycle racks, water fountain and bins

\*Construction will stop over the peak Christmas - New Year trading period. Council is currently exploring options to extend the no-construction period. We will advise our community of the outcome of these investigations as soon as possible.

## What to expect during construction

Council's construction contractors will make every effort to minimise impacts to our community where practical and safe to do so.

Vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist access will **remain available** to Memorial Drive, Etheridge Street and nearby streets.

Access will **remain available** to local businesses and markets, during standard business and market trading hours.

Large machinery will be in operation and intermittent medium-high level noise can be expected. Dust suppression methods will be used as required.

# Temporary changes to traffic and parking conditions

All major changes to traffic conditions including partial detours, lane closures, on street parking and night works will be advised in advance via Construction Notifications such as this one.

To ensure maximum parking availability for our community, construction workers' private vehicles will be parked off site, and a construction compound/office located off site.

Traffic control will be used as required to ensure the safety of our community and construction workers, for example, when large vehicles are entering or leaving construction zones, construction activity is taking place near or across live traffic lanes, or on public footpaths. Alternative pedestrian and cyclist pathways may be in place at times.
